Safety Officer Dean Berry and Commissioner Bob Hoffman will create a list and decide who is in need of new gear. The safety office vest also came in.

VC John Hoffman called the cell tower company. The company is waiting to hear from someone else about our site location and will contact us with any new information. VC also reported the pagers are in.

C Bob Hoffman will order the brackets and pack tracks from state contract.

New Business:

VC John Hoffman reported the ladder pump and tower will have testing done the beginning of May.

Secretary Jessaca Wilford will contact Verizon Wireless to be added as a contact.

Safety Officer Dean Berry reported that the inspector said the propane tanks need to be moved and carbon monoxide detectors need to be installed. Dean suggested possibly running a line to the back building so there is no longer a need for propane. VC John suggested if we do that to insulate the back building.

VC John Hoffman will call the generator service company that the township uses to set up an initial service. After the initial service, John will ask for our services to take place when the township generators are being serviced.

C Bob Hoffman suggested looking into solar panels. He will talk to someone from Laurel Lake Fire Company to get information on the company they used and how it went.

Treasurer Report:

Treasurer Mike Rodgers and Commissioner Bob Hoffman Jr (Compliance Commissioner) reviewed all bills, purchase orders and checks for the month. The bill list was submitted and read aloud for all present. After the bill list was read, all Commissioners voted in favor of paying submitted bills.
