Solar panel visit was successful. A lot of information was delivered and an email contact was given if there are further questions. Four main questions were answered during the meeting.

Installation should take place in the Spring. There is no upfront cost.

An inactive phone number was removed from the Verizon Wireless account.

Turnout gear is on its way. The company is waiving the shipping fee due to the delay.

**New Business:**

Commissioner Bob Hoffman heard of a firefighter who had a stroke on a scene and the Joint Insurance Fund denied his coverage. He will call JIF to confirm the company's coverage plan.

Once quote on the front apron and black top replacement has come in from Rocco Arno Asphalt in Rosenhayn. Commissioner Bob will get two more quotes.

Vice Chairman John Hoffman has a new phone on the way from Verizon Wireless.
